Dr. Miriam Seyda is (full) professor for physical education and sport didactics and head of the School and Teaching Department at the Institute for Sport and Sport Science at Technical University of Dortmund. Her research is primarily concerned with professionalisation of physical education (PE) teachers, especially the development of professional competences, the design of PE lessons and its effects on students.

Seyda studied sports science, psychology and german language and literature at the University of Oldenburg (until 2004), worked as a researcher at the TU Dortmund until 2013, completing her doctorate in 2010. From 2013 to 2018 she was a junior professor for physical education, play and sports in childhood at the WWU Münster, and from 2018 to 2022 she held the chair of sport pedagogy and sports didactics at the University of Flensburg, before she took up her current professorship at TU Dortmund University
